Pineapple Pretzel Fluff

INGREDIENTS:

1 cup coarsely crushed pretzels 1/2 cup butter, melted 1 cup sugar, divided 1 package (8oz) cream cheese, softened 1 can (20oz) crushed pineapple, drained 1 carton (12oz) frozen whipped topping, thawed

DIRECTIONS:

Combine pretzels, butter and ½ cup sugar.

 γ Press into a 9x13-inch pan. Bake at 400°F for 7 Zminutes, Cool

3 Meanwhile, beat cream cheese and remaining sugar until creamy. Fold in pineapple and whipped topping. Chill until serving.

Break pretzel mixture into small pieces and stir 4 into pineapple mixture just before serving.
