SERVICE AGREEMENTS

- 3-1 Application for Service - The Utility may require a Customer or prospective Customer to sign one of the Utility's standard application or service agreement forms. The application or agreement shall be binding only after acceptance of service by a duly authorized representative of the Utility and once accepted by the Utility, all terms and conditions therein shall be binding on the Customer. In the case where an agreement is not required by the Utility, Customer shall pay for the service so furnished in accordance with the applicable rate schedule or schedules in force at the time of service and shall abide by and be subject to all Commission-approved Electric Tariff rules. A Customer requiring the construction of a line extension, as described in Rule No. 6, may be required to sign a service agreement whereby service is contracted for a period of not less than two years.
